From Charter Club Chairman to Craig Hone:

1. As I understand things, the original waiver covered two SCW issues that existed back in 1978: The Sun Cities Senior Softball League (SCSSL) did not comply with the SCW Rules, Regulation, and Procedures for Chartered Clubs. When the SCW Softball Club (SCWSC) was created in 2000, that violation was eliminated. At that point, the waiver covered only the Reciprocity Agreement violation (see #2 below).
2. The waiver from the past is no longer valid but will be grandfathered under the proposal as co-mingling SC and SCW players on the same team is a violation of the reciprocity agreement which states that SC and SCW players must be on their own teams.
3. The proposal states that the waiver period is 12 months, which must coincide with the reciprocity agreement period.
4. The reciprocity agreement and waiver are different but related, as stated in #1 above.
5. My understanding is that the SCWSC has three voting options:
  - a. Accept the 4 October 2022 proposal as presented, which requires an annual reciprocity agreement and waiver approved by the SCW Governing Board. An annual reciprocity agreement and a waiver are required.
  - b. Request an annual reciprocity agreement from the Recreation Manager and General Manager that does not involve a waiver. SCW and SC teams consisting ONLY of players from each community can play each other according to the terms of the mutual reciprocity agreements. No waiver is required.
  - c. Create teams consisting ONLY of SCW players and play each other, i.e., no outside community players are involved. No reciprocity agreement or waiver are required.

Items 5.a and 5.b will require that the SCW Softball Club somehow determine that its members wish to continue reciprocity and the waiver under option 5.a or reciprocity only under option 5.b. Should the SCWSC elect not to proceed with the 4 October 2022 proposal (5.a above), the proposal will no longer be valid and will be retracted. Similarly, the old waiver agreement will be declared invalid and will not be grandfathered.

In order to have true reciprocity, a SCW organization wanting to engage with outside entities must sign a SCW reciprocity agreement. The SCW reciprocity agreement protects

the Association should an outside player become injured on our property, among other things.

The other party must sign a reciprocity agreement with its governing body. This is necessary to protect SCW players should they become injured when playing on other communities' property. Reciprocity must be a two-way street.

Regarding the question about SC's reciprocity agreement, I'm unable to answer that question because I'm not familiar with their policies. As for the SC softball club requiring a waiver, that's their issue to address. Each community governs itself; as such, SCW cannot abide by SC's governance standards. I imagine they'd say the same about abiding by SCW governance standards.

The 4 October 2022 proposal was laid out to help maintain the playing arrangement of the SCW Softball Club. It also puts the onus on the club to request an exception to an Association policy, which, as the benefactor of the exception, lies squarely on the club. Should the 4 October 2022 proposal be accepted, the responsibility for renewing the reciprocity agreement and the waiver will belong to the Sun City West Softball Club. The method used by the club to determine how to move forward each year will also belong to the club. The waiver will expire if the club takes no action before the end of the grace period (yet to be determined).

The Governing Board's involvement will be to approve or deny the waiver request each year.

**Reciting of Pledge of Allegiance**

**Shelly Hilton reread the 4/6/22 General Membership Meeting Minutes.**

**Motion was made to approve the 4/6/22 General Membership Meeting Minutes as read, Seconded, and Approved.**

**Treasurer's Report – Paul Felice:** Treasurer's report was read. See Attachment

Discussion: Will the Rec. Center be able to take our monies or are we able to keep for us to improve our club. At this point, they will not be able to take our money. Did the Board send in an AUDIT last year? The board did send in and it needs to be done yearly.

**Motion was made to approve the Treasurer's Report as read, Seconded, and Approved.**

**Committees:**

**AL – Nick Missos:** AL is doing well; 1 undefeated team remaining. Jim Montgomery has stepped down as the lead for Umpires in AL. Dwight Nichols will now be overseeing the umpires for SCW. Steve Glaviano is doing the same in Sun City. Kudos to Jim Montgomery for all his work. Pete Laufer stepped down from AL Chairperson. In the meantime, Nick Missos is the AL Representative until a new AL Chairperson is found. Let Nick know if you are interested in positions on the AL Committee, as vacancies are coming up in January 2023. Kudos to Rick Staeb for taking care of AL writeups on his own.

Discussion: What do our by-laws say about appointing committee reps from SC and SCW and who actually approves. There was a revision that appears to be dated 11/30/21. Need to look through board meetings to find out when this revision and approval took place. This was tabled.

**CL – Jim Kriedler:** CL has 12 teams; there are players ready to step in right away, if needed. CL has 2 5-rated players and 1 6-rated player on sub-list. This is being managed by the Substitute Coordinator. Jim receives data consistently to keep track of subs that have played, how much they've played, etc.

**NL – Dennis Horvath:** 11 teams, 121 players; 13-sub only; None in placement pool; 1 undefeated team now. New fielder's choice rule. Courtesy runner rule has been simplified. There are 2 players currently in the NL are in their 90s.

**70s Team – Lloyd Styrwoll:** 10 teams (6 red teams – ratings (1-5) (4 blue teams – ratings (6-9)). We play one session all year long; just one draft; Session ends 4/9/23. Dennis Horvath will look at 70s League in Sports Engine to see what is and isn't there for that league.

**Co-Ed – Phil Souza:** Had our first game 1 month ago Friday and then Wednesday afternoon. We rotate alternating weeks between SCW and SC. Ron Coppess informed us today that they are unable to provide Wednesdays to play Co-ed in SC. There are 5 teams total; 60 players; need more females to play; 1 team gets a bye each week; Starts with 0-0 and 1 to waste. If tied at end of 7 innings, they play one more inning. Slow-runner rule is in effect. Ratings are 5-9 in Co-Ed league; 130ft ARC in outfield.

**Women's League – Bev Burger:** Games have been scheduled; possible new uniforms; First game is 11/19/22, then 12/10 (3-way tourney) with Pebble Creek and Grand. 15 Women were at last practice. We are reciprocating.

**Field Management – Ken Skinner:** Liberty Field is in excellent condition. Overseeding went well.

**Events – Ken Skinner:** 12/10/22 – Hot Flash Tourney starting at 9am; 12/10/22 Teams to Palm Desert. First Saturday in February is Cardiac Kids; First two weekends in March is Spring Flings

**Safety Committee – Ken Skinner:** Working on AED/CPR Training – Hoping to be done before Christmas; Committee chairpersons will need to be there. Safety Committee is required to have a Safety Meeting and formally write up minutes.

**Green Team – Jim Montgomery:** Green Team takes place on Fridays after the AL game. Reps from each league are invited to be there. This is where new players are put through a skills assessment, rated, and placed on a team. The new player contacts the Equipment Manager to set up a time to collect uniform. Money should not exchange hands with Equipment Mgr. Kudos to Jim Montgomery for the hard work he puts into Green Team.

**Equipment Manager - Matt Schacht:** Had to order MacGregor Softballs since Rocks have not been available. Over a year ago, an order of Rocks were placed, and we have yet to receive them or a delivery date; All other inventory is stocked, except shorts – where a large order has been placed; Gray shorts are more available than blue, though both are the same price. We need to coordinate colors with SC; We are good, however, through Spring of this coming year. We will table this topic.

Each League has their own equipment representative: AL – Nick Missos; CL – Jim Kreidler; NL – Lauren Vogt, and Rick Hilton also is there to help. We are running low on hats and will go back to “fitted” hats.

**Under 70s League – Matt Schacht:** Matt was asked to step-in and head-up the Under 70s league. This league will be put on hold until Spring. We still need more details in place before we begin.

**Angels in the Outfield – Donna Laufer:** - See attachment

**Tin Cup – Orié MacDonald:** SCW Annual Fundraising Tin Cup is 4/2/23 at Deer Valley and Trail Ridge. Dinner at Palm Ridge. Meeting is 11/29/22 at Orié's house. Volunteers needed; Have reserved golf courses; Peoria VW has been contacted.

**Food/Beverages – Dottie Johnson:** Thanks to Nick Missos, Jack Gilbert, and Craig Hone for smoking brisket for the BBQ. We had 325 people at Welcome Back BBQ. Thanks to everyone who made this event successful. Next event is set for 12/10/22 (Hot Flash Tourney). Dennis and Connie Horvath will be BBQing hamburgers.

**Database – Dennis Horvath:** Staff of 8; in the past 6 months, several forms have been created; Camera installation project is still pending; Member Search is down on the website so that they can do a “remake”. We will end up having phone numbers and emails. Club members will be able to opt out; Welcome Dave Baldwin to the staff. We have 3.5 persons trained to take Dennis Horvath's job; Need to update website with correct committee member names. Kudos to Rick Fish and all he has done in Sun City.

**Bill Boards – Dave Ryg:** BB Rules, per Rec Center, have changed; All BB look great. Ray's biggest concerns are when replacing the outfield fence – that he have enough notification to take them down for the project.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

**By-Law Update – Craig:** The Rec Center has recently changed the format for the By-Laws

**CR13 Status – Bob Lee:** Many meetings took place (finance, budget, planning, etc) – one meeting being 7.5 hours. Two weeks later, the Charter Club Committee wanted us back to ask more questions. Now, the Governing Board will decide what happens. We asked for \$2.5 Million. The Rec Center ends up attaching a price they feel is appropriate to each project. We prioritize our projects for the Charter Club Committee and #1 is the outfield fence.

**Status of 501c7 to c3 – Dave Ryg:** Just received the revised By-Laws; Continuing to work on prepping for conversion. 1023 form is \$600 to submit to IRS; Now that a couple of clubs have converted, we can use their examples to help us; Craig will set up a meeting with Kasey and Dori to help us proceed; We are told it takes about 6 months for the transition.

Discussion: If a club member has a suggestion for a charitable organization to donate, what is the procedure? Approach the Board with the information and if approved/recorded in minutes, we move forward. There would be no limits.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Veteran's Day Game:** Game will be held in Sun City

**Fireman's Game:** In the process of setting up.

**Hall of Fame – Dwight Nichols:** This event will be 3/12/23 in Sun City West. Will be asking for Volunteers; Tickets available first of February – ready to sell to players on each team; Sponsors will be invited.

**Selection Committee – Dan Burke:** Four Hall-of-Famers and 3 Non-HOF are on the selection committee. Ballot will be placed on our website by January 10, 2023; Ballots will also be in the clubhouse; We will hold a meeting after Thanksgiving.

**Co-Mingling:** Voting to be held on paper ballots 4 different dates: 11/9/22 at tonight's meeting; 11/11/14, 11/15, 11/17 at Liberty Field during the games. Ballots will be dropped into a locked box. The Club Member will first check in with monitor, vote, and then drop into locked box.

**Election Committee – Paul Felice/Lloyd Styrwoll:** Each Candidate will have 2 minutes to introduce him/herself.

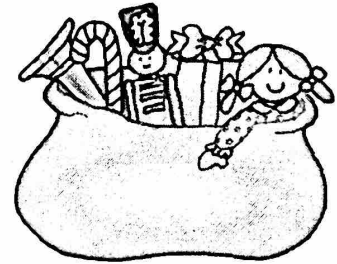
