

SUN CITIES SOFTBALL LEAGUE
BOARD MEETING
MAY 13, 2002

Meeting called to order by President Matt Szydowski at 1:13 PM

Board members absent- Bob Luebben, Wayne Mitchell and Dick LeMoine.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with one correction. Greg Johnston was listed as a guest at the last meeting. Please let the minutes reflect that he is a Board Director.

- ◆ Three letters, pertaining to a player being ejected from a game, one the umpire, one from his manager and one from the League President, were read. A one game suspension will be served by the player the first game of the October, 2002 session.
 - ◆ Uniform committee will select shirts to be purchased and will be replaced on a scheduled basis. Probably every four years. Current cost is \$18.00 to \$23.50 for each shirt.
 - ◆ A long sleeved shirt that would be the same for everyone, to be worn under the sponsors shirt in cooler weather, is being looked into.
 - ◆ **TruGreen ChemLawn** will be a new sponsor with it's team playing in the American League.
 - ◆ Assistants to be appointed to work with Bob Stouthamer with sponsors should be representatives of Sun City, Sun City West, the National League and the American League. Peg Swanson and Gene O'Boyle have Volunteered.
 - ◆ Northern Trust is interested in having a seminar, on Identity Theft, for all players, wives and guests to be held at a date to be announced in the fall.
 - ◆ With the information that is available now, it appears we should have 13 teams in each league in October.
 - ◆ The second session of the summer league will have 6 teams in the National league and 4 in the American.
 - ◆ A survey provided by Al Schifini indicated there were enough interested players to form a Major/Minor American league. After considerable discussion with both pros and cons, a motion made by Jack Borst and seconded by Greg Johnston that the Board table this proposal. A proposal submitted by Steve Griswold that would have one American league and a National league with **two equal divisions**, made up of nine teams each, was also tabled.
 - ◆ A letter from Ken Skinner, regarding the use of fields in Surprise, was submitted. This letter is posted on all bulletin boards at our fields. Teams that would be sponsored by our league or our clubs would require Board approval. If individuals want to establish teams to participate in that league, it would be at their own expense.
