Be sure the inner box lines are 6 inches from the base. Sometimes lines have been drawn nearly on the base forcing players to back up almost out of the box. Per Chief Umpire Skinner, If the ump sees improperly laid lines, he should erase the box if time cannot be taken to redo it. Play then continues without a box.
