Session Rules:

- 1 Come to field ½ hour early as games may start 10 minutes early if field is clear.
- 2 Start 1 and 1 with 1 to waste
- 3 Only Managers are to protest to Umpires
- 4 Mercy Rules:
 - Flip if Visiting Team is ahead by 3+ runs
 - If 1 team is ahead by 12 after 5 or 10 after 6 game over
- 5 No Tie breakers or extra innings. Each team get ½ point for a tie.
- 6 Women will hit the 11” ball, Men the regular ball

- 7 Home Team of first game sets up the field, and Home Team of last game secures th
- 8 Home Team of Second game provides scorekeeper(s) for the first game.
- 9 Visiting Team provides scorekeeper(s) for the game after theirs.
- 10 Anyone may run as a courtesy runner 1 time per inning (up to 7 innings)
- 11 Must run for the pitcher with 2 outs.
- 12 Infield practice for first inning only.
- 13 Pitchers will have 5 warm up pitches first inning and 2 every other inning thereafte
- 14 Live ball at the fence if it can be seen.

Put ratings on score sheets and list absent players!

Don't forget: A ball that reaches the grass before it is touched, and the batter makes it to first, is counted as a hit even if an out is made at another base.
