NL Spring Rules

1. Come to field $\frac{1}{2}$ hour early as games may start 10 minutes early if field is clear.
2. Tuesday AM games: 55 min clock (ensure we give AL the field on time)
3. Friday PM games: 60 min clock (get that extra inning in if possible)
4. Start 1:1 with 1 to waste
5. Only Managers are to protest to Umpires
6. Mercy Rules:
 - a) Flip if Visiting Team is ahead by 3+ runs
 - b) If 1 team is ahead by 12 after 5 or 10 after 6 game over
7. No Tie breakers or extra innings. Each team get $\frac{1}{2}$ point for a tie.
8. Women will hit the 11" ball and may use a tournament bat (designated with a yellow tape)
9. Men the regular 12" ball and may not use a tournament bat (no yellow tape)
10. Home Team of first game sets up the field, and Home Team of last game secures the field.
11. Home Team of Second game provides scorekeeper(s) for the first game.
12. Visiting Team provides scorekeeper(s) for the game after theirs.
13. Anyone may run as a courtesy runner 1 time per inning (up to 7 innings)
 - a) Courtesy runners must be requested by the player either when on base or before batting.
 - b) Pitcher must get courtesy runner with 2 outs to prepare for next inning.
14. Infield practice for first inning only.
15. Pitchers will have 5 warm up pitches first inning and 2 every other inning thereafter. (Change of pitcher gets 5 warm ups)
16. Live ball at the fence if it can be seen.
 - a) If a fielder touches a ball at the fence, it's not stuck even if they thought it was.
 - b) Only an Umpire may say the ball is stuck and declare a "Ground Rule Double". An Umpire may also declare the ball is not stuck, and all runners are safe where ever they may be at the time of the declaration.
17. Substitute players: see NL Rules
